Abstract Submission Guidelines

Tirana, Albania | 4–5 June 2026

Scope of the Conference

The International Conference on Medicine and Translational Biosciences (ICMTB 2026) welcomes the submission of original research abstracts from researchers, clinicians, healthcare professionals, biomedical engineers, and industry experts.

The conference promotes interdisciplinary research that connects laboratory discoveries, clinical innovation, and technological advances with real-world healthcare impact.

Submission Method

Abstracts must be submitted **exclusively through the online submission system** available on the conference website.

- Email submissions will not be accepted.
- Authors may revise their submission until the deadline.
- One presenting author must be designated during submission.

During submission, authors will be asked to:

- Select a scientific track
- Indicate presentation preference (**Oral / Poster**)
- Provide full author and affiliation information
- Confirm compliance with ethical standards

Authors may indicate their preferred presentation format (oral or poster); however, the Scientific Committee reserves the right to determine the final presentation format.



Scientific Tracks

Each submission must be aligned with **one primary track**:

1. Translational Medicine and Clinical Research
2. Precision Medicine and Advanced Therapeutics
3. Biomedical Innovation, Digital Health and Artificial Intelligence
4. Regenerative Medicine and Translational Pharmaceutical Sciences
5. Global Health and Organ-System Translational Research

Abstract Content and Structure

Abstracts should clearly present:

- the research question or objective
- the methodology used
- key findings
- the scientific or clinical relevance

The following structure is recommended:

Background – Methods – Results – Conclusions

A structured format is encouraged but not mandatory.

Formatting and Language Requirements

Each abstract must include title, authors, affiliations, text.

- Maximum length: **300 words**
 - Word count applies to the abstract body only
 - Title, authors, and affiliations are excluded from the word count
- Tables, figures, images, and graphical elements are not permitted
- References should be avoided unless essential
- Abbreviations must be defined upon first use
- Special formatting (bold, italics, symbols) should be kept minimal.



- The title should be concise and informative
- Do not write the title in **ALL CAPS**
- Do not end the title with a period
- All abstracts must be written and presented in **English**.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring linguistic accuracy prior to submission.

Authorship, Affiliations, and Ethical Compliance

- Provide full first and last names of all authors
- The presenting author must be clearly indicated
- Institutional affiliation must be listed for each author
- Include city and country for all affiliations.
- Maximum recommended number of authors: up to 20
- All authors must approve the submission prior to upload.
- By submitting an abstract, authors confirm that:
 - The work is original and unpublished
 - All co-authors have approved the submission
 - Ethical approvals have been obtained where required
 - Data protection and copyright regulations are respected

Review Process

All abstracts will undergo peer review by the Scientific Committee.

Evaluation criteria include:

- Relevance to conference themes
- Scientific quality and originality
- Clarity of objectives and methodology
- Strength of results and conclusions
- Potential impact in medicine or biosciences

The decision of the Scientific Committee is final.

Awards and Young Investigator Recognition

ICMTB 2026 will recognize outstanding scientific contributions through the following awards:

- **Best Oral Presentation Award**



- **Best Poster Presentation Award**
- **Young Investigator Award**

The Young Investigator Award is intended for early-career researchers, including PhD candidates, postdoctoral fellows, and researchers within approximately five years of completing their doctoral degree.

Notification of Results

Presenting authors will receive email notification regarding:

- Acceptance or rejection
- Assigned presentation format
- Session allocation (if applicable)

Registration Requirement

At least one author of each accepted abstract must register for the conference and present the work onsite.

Conference Fees and Payment

Registration Fee: 100 €

Reduced rate available for students (proof of student status required).

The conference fee includes:

- Participation in all conference sessions and activities
- Lunch on 4 and 5 June
- Coffee breaks
- Conference materials
- Conference publications

Travel and accommodation costs are the responsibility of participants.



The official conference payment currency is EURO.
